## **BYLAW NO. 369**

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE THE RATES OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED AGAINST ASSESSABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF GRANDVIEW, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE 2023 TAXATION YEAR.

Whereas, the Summer Village of Grandview, in the Province of Alberta, has prepared and adopted detailed estimates of the municipal revenues and expenditures required for the taxation year 2023 at the council meeting held on March 24, 2023; and

Whereas, the estimated municipal revenues and transfers from all sources other than general municipal taxation are estimated at \$ 94,141 and

Whereas, the estimated municipal expenditures and transfers (excluding non-cash items) set out in the budget for the Summer Village of Grandview, in the Province of Alberta, for 2023 total \$ 322,635 and the balance is \$ 228,494.

**THEREFORE,** the total amount to be raised by general municipal taxation is \$ 228,494 and

**Whereas**, Council of the Summer Village of Grandview, in the Province of Alberta, is required each year to levy on the assessed value of all property tax rates sufficient to meet the estimated expenditures and requisitions; and

**Whereas**, Council is authorized to classify assessed property and to establish different rates of taxation in respect to each class of property, subject to the *Municipal Government Act*, Chapter M26, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000; and

**Whereas**, the assessed value of all property in the Summer Village of Grandview, in the Province of Alberta, as shown on the assessment roll is:

**Now therefore**, under the authority of the *Municipal Government Act*, Council of the Summer Village of Grandview, in the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. That the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to levy the following rates of taxation on the assessed value of all property as shown on the assessment roll of the Summer Village of Grandview, in the Province of Alberta:
